There are, however, some items missing from the HELAA response form sent to us in relation to your submission for land at Wellcome Genome Campus, Hinxton.

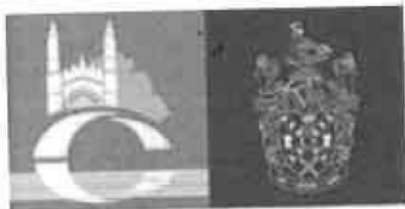
Accordingly, please now supply the following information and return it to us, at your earliest convenience:
